## ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON CURRICULUM 2020-2021

In alignment with the implementation of Outcome-Based Education (OBE), our institution has undertaken significant steps to enhance the curriculum and ensure it meets the evolving needs of students and the job market. To support this initiative, the college has instituted a systematic feedback analysis system.
