
ALUMNI FEEDBACK ANALYSIS ON CURRICULUM (2021-22)

For the academic year 2021-22, the feedback about the syllabus was collected from the stakeholders. All these feedbacks were collected by using a five-point rating scale and analysed using excel software.

ALUMNI FEEDBACK ANALYSIS ON CURRICULUM

The alumni feedback form consists of questions that truly indicated their satisfaction level of the alumni about the syllabus. Given below are the conclusions obtained by analyzing the alumni feedback for the academic year 2021-22.

- Around 74 % of alumni agreed that the curriculum was good for their course during their term in the college.
- The quality of education imparted in the curriculum was very good for 59% of them.
- The course curriculum fulfilling their expectations to 55 % of them.
- 74% of the alumni agree that the curriculum bridge the gap between industry and academia.
- For 61 % of respondents the curriculum is relevant for their present job.
- The Course content in the curriculum helped 53 % of the students to pursue higher studies/Research.
- For 70% of respondents the academic initiatives in the curriculum (Eg: Innovative teaching learning methodologies, Seminar, Workshop, study tour) helped to improve their competence as a student.
- About 63% of respondents agree that developmental activities in the curriculum organized by the college helped for their overall development.
- Around 66% of alumni agree that they learnt new skills through the curriculum from the Farook College during their course of study.
