EMPLOYER FEEDBACK ANALYSIS ON CURRICULUM

The employer feedback form consists of questions that truly indicated their satisfaction level of the alumni about the syllabus. Given below are the conclusions obtained by analyzing the employer feedback for the academic year 2021-22.

• A considerable majority (89%) rates individuals' communication skills as either excellent or very good, indicating a strong perception of effective communication abilities.

• An overwhelming majority (92.6%) believes individuals are highly efficient in developing practical solutions, reflecting a high level of confidence in their problem-solving capabilities.

• A significant proportion (81.4%) acknowledges individuals' interest in working as part of a team, emphasizing the importance of collaborative efforts and team dynamics.

• A substantial percentage (80.7%) rates individuals' planning and organization skills as either excellent or very good, demonstrating confidence in their ability to organize and manage tasks effectively.


• The majority (79.1%) agrees or strongly agrees that individuals are selfmotivated and take on an appropriate level of responsibility, highlighting a positive perception of their work ethic.

• While opinions are mixed, a significant portion (68.4%) acknowledges individuals' openness to new ideas and learning new techniques, indicating a willingness to adapt and grow.

• A substantial percentage (72.6%) rates individuals as either excellent or very good in contributing to organizational goals, suggesting a positive view of their impact on organizational objectives.

• Almost half (49.2%) strongly agrees that individuals possess excellent leadership qualities, contributing to a positive overall assessment of leadership skills.

- A large majority (83.4%) rates individuals' relationships with seniors, peers, and subordinates as excellent or very good, reflecting strong interpersonal skills.
- An overwhelming majority (83%) believes individuals are highly involved in social activities, showcasing a positive perception of their engagement beyond academic and professional domains.
- A significant portion (73.3%) acknowledges individuals' ability to take up extra responsibility, with 40.1% rating it as excellent, indicating a high level of trust in their capacity for additional tasks.
- The majority (76.1%) either agrees or strongly agrees that individuals are willing to work beyond the regular schedule if required, highlighting a positive work ethic.
- An overwhelming majority (86.4%) expresses either excellent or very good satisfaction with Farook College or the curriculum, showcasing a high level of contentment among the respondents.
